This program is modular in nature, so you can pick up where you left off - at your convenience. The six modules will help you enhance your learning leadership and staff learning development capabilities. At the successful completion of the program, and after a one-day forum, you will be eligible to receive the Diploma of Learning Leadership (Knowledgeable Leader). The forum is a great way to interact with other professionals with similar experiences and exchange insights and advice.

Program modules:
