Program overview

As a leader, you need to have the confidence to manage employee development while developing knowledge resources. The Knowledge in Action Program is here to help! You will learn how to plan for knowledge resources, operationalise critical knowledge, present knowledge for change, guide knowledgeable inquiry, use knowledge to manage risk and more. Get ready to empower yourself and your team with the knowledge and resources needed for success.

This course offers a flexible, open learning approach, using cases to develop professional capabilities - with direct implications for your workplace. Your learning will be based on the latest research in learning and leadership. You will learn about the importance of capability development for individuals and organisations. The course will take you beyond thinking about employees as 'human resources', towards developing them as knowledge resources. The program teaches techniques to effectively manage the learning process and build the learning culture required by every organisation.

In addition, by combining the Knowledge in Action Program with College membership, you will also get a diploma and a network that adds to your resume as a leader with a great aptitude for driving learning.



Details

This program is modular in nature, so you can pick up where you left off - at your convenience. The six modules will help you enhance your learning leadership and staff learning development capabilities. At the successful completion of the program, and after a one-day forum, you will be eligible to receive the Diploma of Learning Leadership (Knowledge in Action). The forum is a great way to interact with other professionals with similar experiences and exchange insights and advice.

Program modules:
